## **C. Carl Cunningham Rotary Scholarship**

*For students graduating from Concordia High School with plans to attend any accredited post secondary school.*

Criteria:

- Applicants must be candidates for graduation from Concordia High School.
- Applicants must plan to attend any accredited post-secondary school, including a college, university, technical or vocational school.
- Recipients will be selected upon their completion of the application form, high school grade point average, high school activities, personal financial need and essay prepared on the “Four Way Test” of Rotary International and possible presentation of their essay at a weekly Concordia Rotary Club meeting.

## **Wendy Ann Koch Memorial Scholarship**

*For students graduating from Clifton-Clyde High School with plans to attend any accredited post secondary school.*

Criteria:

- Applicants must be candidates for graduation from Clifton-Clyde High School.
- Applicants must plan to attend any accredited post-secondary school, including a college, university, technical or vocational school.
- Applicants must submit an essay which presents their high school activities, civic or church related activities, future education plans, and occupational goals and plans.
