

Foundation grant helps pool reopen

The swimming pool at the Sisters of St. Joseph Motherhouse will reopen Monday, Oct. 5, thanks in part to a grant from the Community Foundation for Cloud County.

The 55,000-gallon pool has been closed this week as workers replaced a circulation pump that failed and replaced drainage grates to **comply with new federal safety** regulations. The project cost approximately \$1,250.

Foundation chairman Bob Steimel presented the

Sisters of St. Joseph with \$500 toward that cost, so the pool could reopen to the public.

As many as 60 people a week from throughout Cloud County use the 25-by-50-foot heated pool during "public hours," from 8 a.m.-6 p.m., weekdays. It is the only indoor pool in Concordia that is open to the public.

Swimmers interested in using the pool may reserve a time by calling the Motherhouse receptionist, 243-2113.
