## Sisters of St. Joseph establish fund in CFCC

The Community Foundation for Cloud County (CFCC) has announced that Nazareth Convent and Academy Corporation has established the Sisters of St. Joseph of Concordia Fund as an organization fund in the Community Foundation.

Organization funds are established by nonprofit organizations as a source of long-term endowment and annual income. The Foundation provides administrative, investment, and accounting services for these endowments. Organizations may request to receive annual distribution from their fund, or simply let their fund continue to grow for their future needs.
