

Community Foundation awards grants

At the April 24 quarterly board of governors meeting of the Community Foundation for Cloud County (CFCC), chairman Bob Steimel reported that the Foundation has a community investment of more than \$1,065,000.

Steimel also reported that the Foundation's annual summary that summarizes the history of the Foundation shows a total community investment of \$1,046,883, total earnings of \$335,000 and total grants awarded of \$240,000 since the Foundation's inception. Since July 1, 2007, the Foundation has awarded grants of more than \$101,000.

The board of governors ratified or approved the following grants since the last quarterly board meeting: **Wendy Ann Koch Memorial Scholarship Fund**, \$250 scholarship grant to Anna Rogers, Clyde; **Pauline and Richard A. Cook Family Scholarship Fund**, \$1,250 scholarship each to Page

Girard, Clyde; Melissa Kyle Stacken, Concordia; Jamie George, Clyde; and Alicia McKenna, Concordia; **Seize the Moment Fund**, \$500 grant to Brown Grand Theatre to assist with arch/wall reinforcement; \$500 grant to Big Brothers/Big Sisters to assist with "Big House" fund raiser; and \$456.55 to Cloud County Development Center for a Flyer Pathfinder wagon and two scooters; **Youth Activity Fund**, \$250 to the Glasco High School to assist with the after-prom party and \$500 to the Concordia High School to assist with the after-prom party; and the **C. Carl Cunningham Rotary Scholarship Fund**, \$1,000 scholarship to Ilene Remley; \$500 scholarship to Whitney Sorell; and \$300 to Jordan Tholstrup. The next board of governors meeting will be July 24.
