Bob Steimel, executive director, and Lorene Steimel, assistant, represented the Community Foundation for Cloud County at the Kansas Association of Community Foundations Regional Training, June 28, in Manhattan.

Morning topics covered during the Endowment Building and Leadership conference were "Building Endowments" and "Building a Team for Foundation Fundraising." In the afternoon, the Kansas Leadership Center presented the topics "Building the Skills for Leadership" and "Applying the Leadership Competencies." Similar regional conferences were held in El Dorado and Scott City on Tuesday and Wednesday.

As part of the GROW II matching grant program, the Kansas Health Foundation is providing, at their cost,

six mentors to the 12 community Foundations who received matching grants. As part of that service program, Michael Batchelor, president of the Erie Community Foundation, spent June 29 familiarizing himself with CFCC.
